I. THE VOLUME OF INTERVENTION ON LOAD-BEARING STRUCTURES

This volume entitled *Intervention on Load-Bearing Structures* is a bilingual (Romanian-Hungarian) publication which intends to fill the lack of bibliography in the field of the theory and terminology of interventions in built heritage conserving. The value of the publication consists in the way it approaches the complexity and actuality of the topic. The book is made up of two parts: the first is about the theory of historic load-bearing structures; the second part presents the aspect of the interventions on these structures (maintenance, preservation, conservation, reconstruction, demolition). The texts are followed by several illustrations and at the end by a glossary with the technical terms, which deals with a broad terminology of this domain, less clarified so far. The publication was issued in cooperation with the Transsylvania Nostra Foundation and with the financial support of the Administration of the National Cultural Fund.

The first one is still in course of conservation; meanwhile the second was finished in summer of 2012. Beside these two articles, other texts were published about structural degradations at listed wooden churches in the Banat Region, about the mechanical testing of the addition mortars at the Báthory Fortress in Şimleu Silvaniei and the historical gardens in Transylvania. The last article represents the start of a new heading of the journal, presenting examples of landscape ensembles with historic value.
