In this new issue we have published the text of Sergiu NISTOR, which presents the terminology and methodology of heritage protection though the revision of international documents, the article of Kázmér KOVÁCS on restoration, as well as that of Dan MOHANU entitled *The Image Reintegration*, respectively the terminology of interventions on historic load-bearing structures, presented by Bálint SZABÓ. The publication was financed by the Romanian Administration of Cultural National Fund.

The first issue from 2011 is dedicated to general problems related to built heritage, presenting, with the aid of richly illustrated sequences, the conservation process of the bronze statues of the Matthias I Sculptural Group, which ended in 2010, and the structural renovation of its pediment. Here are debated the decorative techniques and the typology of the sounding boards, the conservation of the fortified church in Drăuşeni, the rehabilitation of historic doors and windows of the Márton Áron College in Miercurea Ciuc, and also the Transylvanian historic roof structures database. It includes also the statistic analysis of the structure of National Conservation Plan (2007-2010) that outlines the distribution at a national level of the funding assigned to rehabilitation works.

By succeeding partially in supplying the completions that were promised in the preceding volumes, a small step was yet again taken towards achieving the final quality. The dictionary constitutes teaching material that comes to complete the authors' lectures given during the courses: conservation of constructions at the Faculty of Architecture and Urban Planning of the Technical University of Cluj-Napoca and Postgraduate Studies on Historic Building Conservation, organised by the Babeş-Bolyai University from Cluj-Napoca.
